## **Blind Cash-Out Till Reconciliation**

This new feature was developed as a result of a client request, and is a simplified method of till reconciliation which requires the cashier to enter till totals of cash and checks at the end

simply count the cash & checks and report the total to the system without knowing what those numbers are "supposed" to be.

The new cash-out method will help save time during the till reconciliation process, and adds an extra layer of security for cash handling.

At the end of each shift, staff are responsible for their "float" or starting cash balance. Once the float amount is subtracted from the till, the remaining amount is the cash

to remit. Once a till is closed the staff will enter the total cash and check amount that remains after subtracting the float amount. If a shortage or overage is NOT detected the till will be successfully closed and auto-reconciled. If a shortage or overage IS detected the shortage or overage will be displayed and an opportunity will be given for the staff to write a note to explain the discrepancy. This till will then need to be reconciled by a supervisor.



By popular request, we've added a mailing label export feature for reporting. When you click the Export button from a report that includes patron data

(rosters, facility reservations, patron lists, etc.) you'll be given the option for Mail Labels. This handy export has options for printing in all caps, substituting Current Resident in the place of the patron's name, printing to a partial sheet, and more.
