Organization Type Patron Accounts

It feels great to say this often lately: this feature was developed as a direct result of a request from the Sportsman Feature Request Voting Board, and we're thrilled to deliver more of the functionality you've been asking for! We've made it easier to manage organizations that use your facilities by introducing organization-type accounts.

Now, just like you create an account for an individual visiting your recreation center to register for activities or reserve facilities, you can create an account for a business or organization that uses your facility. These organization accounts will have a main contact person and the option to add additional employees as group members.

To mark a patron account as an organization, simply check the Organization Account box above the patron's first name.

Re-Enrollment Now Available on Sportsman Web

The Re-Enrollment feature simplifies managing ongoing enrollment for activities like dance or gymnastics classes, where the same group of participants wants to continue month to month. With this feature, you can select an activity, uncheck any patrons who will not be re-enrolling, and enroll the remaining participants in the upcoming program.

Charges can be processed using an existing card on file or posted to the patron's account, allowing them to pay later—either online through ActivityReg or in person at your organization.

With the Rentals functionality in Sportsman, you can charge patrons a fee to loan items like lockers, ice skates, and sports equipment such as basketballs or ping pong paddles for use in your facilities. While rental sales have been available in Sportsman Web for some time, we've now added the ability to define those rentals directly in Sportsman Web.

Defining rental items is simple—just navigate to Define > Rentals and add or edit your rental options. You can assign timeframes to rental items, ranging from pre-defined hourly timeslots to daily, weekly, monthly, or even annual durations.
