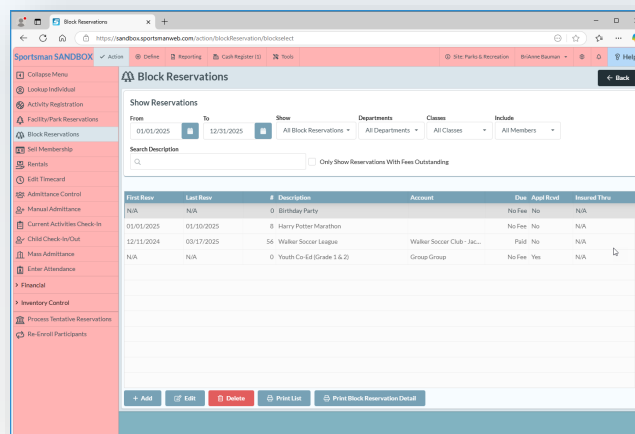

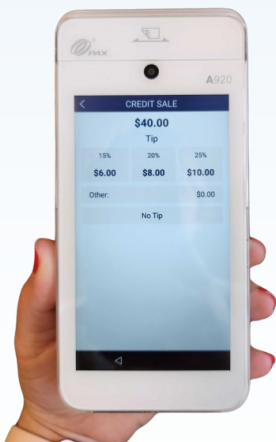

With Sportsman's Tournament Scheduler, you can reserve your fields and facilities and schedule your games in one seamless step.

Participants can view tournament brackets, game schedules, and scores directly on your ActivityReg page, under the Scores and Schedules section of Activities.
