## Required Documents for Activities

We're excited to announce that our Required Documents feature has officially moved out of beta and is now available to all clients. This enhancement gives you full control over how documents are managed withing your registration process. You can define custom document types, specify whether they are required for registration, set expiration terms, establish review requirements, and even upload templates for participants to download.

When assigning required documents to an activity, you'll determine whether they must be submitted at the time of registration or within a defined timeframe afterward. To help keep everything on track, you can also configure automated reminder schedules for any outstanding documents so that nothing falls through the cracks.
